Big Data: Technology, Analysis & Applications

Abstract:

Big Data as a term goes back to the 1998, but gained broader attention only the last 10 years with the wide commercial use of corresponding technologies. In the recent years, it is increasingly discussed in scientific communities, ranging from humanities, over social- and medical sciences to natural sciences. In the presentation we look at Big Data and Big Data Analysis from various angles. We discuss technical as well as data scientific aspects and look at possibilities for Big Data applications in sciences.
